2017 Damoli 'Moraria' Valpolicella Classico DOC ***Valpolicella Classica***

Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella Dry, warm, soft and full bodied on the palate with dark fruits. Fresh and easy on the palate.

2014 Damoli 'Giago' Valpolicella Ripasso Classico DOC

30% Corvina, 40% Corvinone, 30% Rondinella

3 years in small old French barrels.

Black fruits, tar and crème brûlée. On the palate it is dry, warm, soft, full bodied, with rounded tannins perfect blended with ripe red cherry and plum tastes.

2012 Damoli Vini 'Checo' Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOCG

Corvina (40%), Corvinone (35%), Rondinella (25%)

4/5 years into small old french barrels. Aromas of dried prune, cherry and jam. On the palate it is dry, soft, full bodied, with spices, coffee, cocoa, over ripened fruit and balsamic flavors.

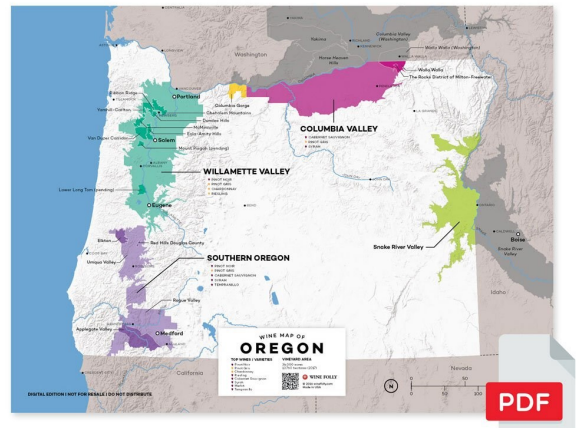
2016 Kagan Cellars 'Roberts Road Vineyard' Pinot Noir–Sonoma

Pommard, Swan, 115 and 667 clones, 20% whole cluster, 30% new French oak for 8 months. This pinot opens with aromas of raspberries, Strawberries and pomegranate. Alive in the glass and approachable on the palate.



2016 Granville Wines 'Holstein Vineyard' Pinot Noir–Willamette

115, 667, 777 and Holstein clones. 10% new oak, 35% 3rd use, 55% neutral French oak for 11 months. Red fruit is prevalent in this wine but it is very well balanced with a bright finish. One of Willamette's best.



2015 Christophe Ferrari Pinot Noir–Iracny, Burgundy

This cuvee comes from an assembly of several parcels all in the Iracny appellation just to the west of Chablis. Aged 8-12 months depending on vintage. The wine is unfinned and lightly filtered. This wine opens with light nuances of cranberry and red fruit. Extremely delicate and refined. Great example of Burgundy.
